- Members meet four times a year; primarily to share case studies with each other, detailing how they use SolidWorks® and related technical tools in their design and fabrication work.
- SolidWorks Corporation, VARs (Value Added Resellers) and other solution providers are invited to give talks when new software features or related products are of interest to the group.
- Time is regularly designated for questions and open discussion on subjects related to SolidWorks®.
- There are over 100 members in MASWUG, with meeting attendance ranging from 50 to 80 people representing 30 to 40 organizations.
- MASWUG is organized and operated completely through volunteer participants. Functions are organized and run by elected officers and are sponsored in part by SolidWorks and area VARs, Graphics Systems and CATI.
- There are no membership dues. MASWUG members need not own SolidWorks®.
- Meetings are held four times a year at various locations around Madison and are typically scheduled for mid-week, 3-6 pm.
